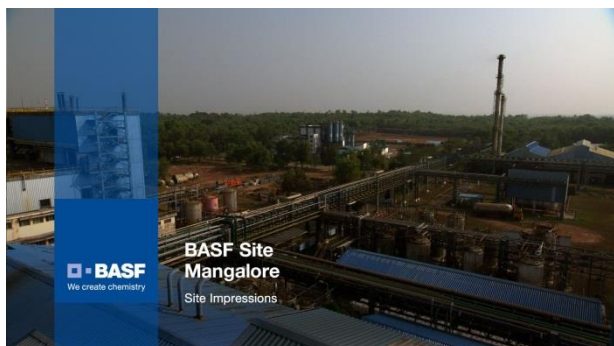
The largest BASF site in South Asia
